Obama's State of Union Address and Infrastructure

President Obama's State of the Union Address referenced the importance of infrastructure to the nation and economy. As in the past, the mention about infrastructure came without any reference to funding. The Administration and Congress are on a collision course over the question of funding as the Republicans want to cut the existing funding levels.

The Republican goal is to reduce funding for domestic programs (including wastewater and drinking water) to 2006 levels. You may recall that two years ago, the Administration and Congress increased funding for the state SRF Program by nearly 300 percent. To return to 2006 funding levels would be devasting for the SRF Program.

The President has proposed a freeze at current funding levels for the next five years. That may not be so bad for the program, when compared to the Republican goal. I will keep you informed of developments and how you might be able to help. This is an issue that former Congressman Roe, Sante Esposito and I will pursue.
