Update On S. 1005 and Coalition Efforts

As noted in our August 23, 2010 Report, Coalition representatives attended a recent Water Infrastructure Network (WIN) Washington, DC meeting that focused on moving S. 1005, Clean Water Reauthorization Act, during the Congressional "Lame Duck" session after the upcoming elections. The "big four" in the Senate, Senators Harry Reid, Richard Durbin, Mitch McConnell and Jon Kyl, will be approached to achieve bipartisan support in scheduling action on S. 1005 following the elections. A copy of one of the communications is enclosed for your review.

We understand that Davis-Bacon and change in funding formula for distribution of funds are remaining issues to be resolved. These matters can be resolved during the Senate floor discussion on the bill.

There will be a time in the future when Coalition members will be asked to contact their U.S. Senators regarding support to bring S. 1005 to the Senate floor. I will keep you informed regarding the timing of this effort.
