The agenda will continue Wednesday morning, April 26 where prominent Members of Congress will deliver remarks. Wednesday afternoon will be reserved for attendees to meet with legislators on Capitol Hill – which is once again fully open to the public. Finally, attendees will round out the week with friends and colleagues at the 2023 Water Week Reception.

President’s FY24 Budget

For the CWSRF \$1.638B and the SDWSRF \$1.126B, which would meet the CWCC Priorities for 2023. The President’s Budget rejects earmarks as a takedown from the base SRF funding. For Title XVI, \$4M, the same as the FY23 Biden Budget but increased by the appropriators to \$60M, of which \$20M was for WIIN grants.
